

## Community Actions

During the development of the Plan, a number of Community Actions were identified that would help to improve our community and help satisfy wider community aspirations. They reflect future work activities that it is proposed be undertaken within the parish which will involve a wide range of third parties alongside the Parish Council to help improve the parish in line with the outcome of community consultation.

Community Actions are not planning policies and are not subject to Examination.

The Community Actions that have emerged through the process of preparing the Neighbourhood Plan are as follows:

### Environment

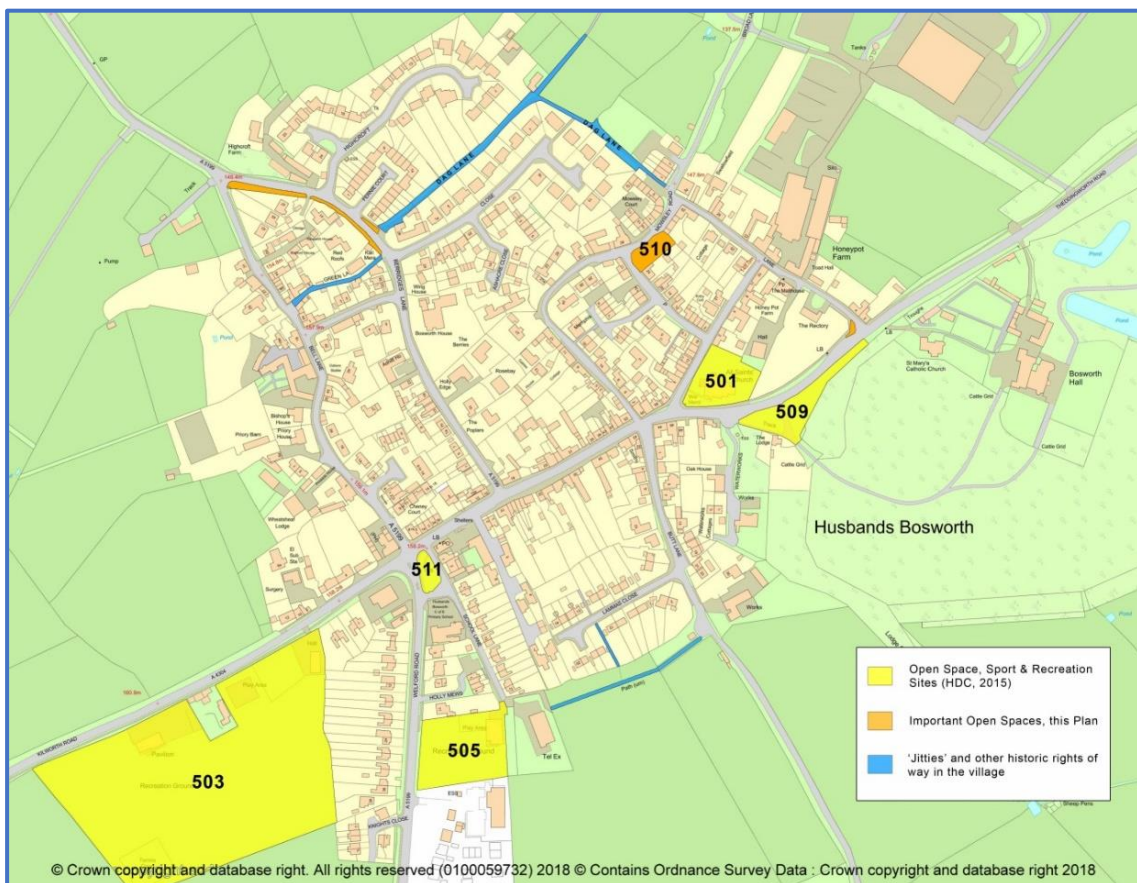
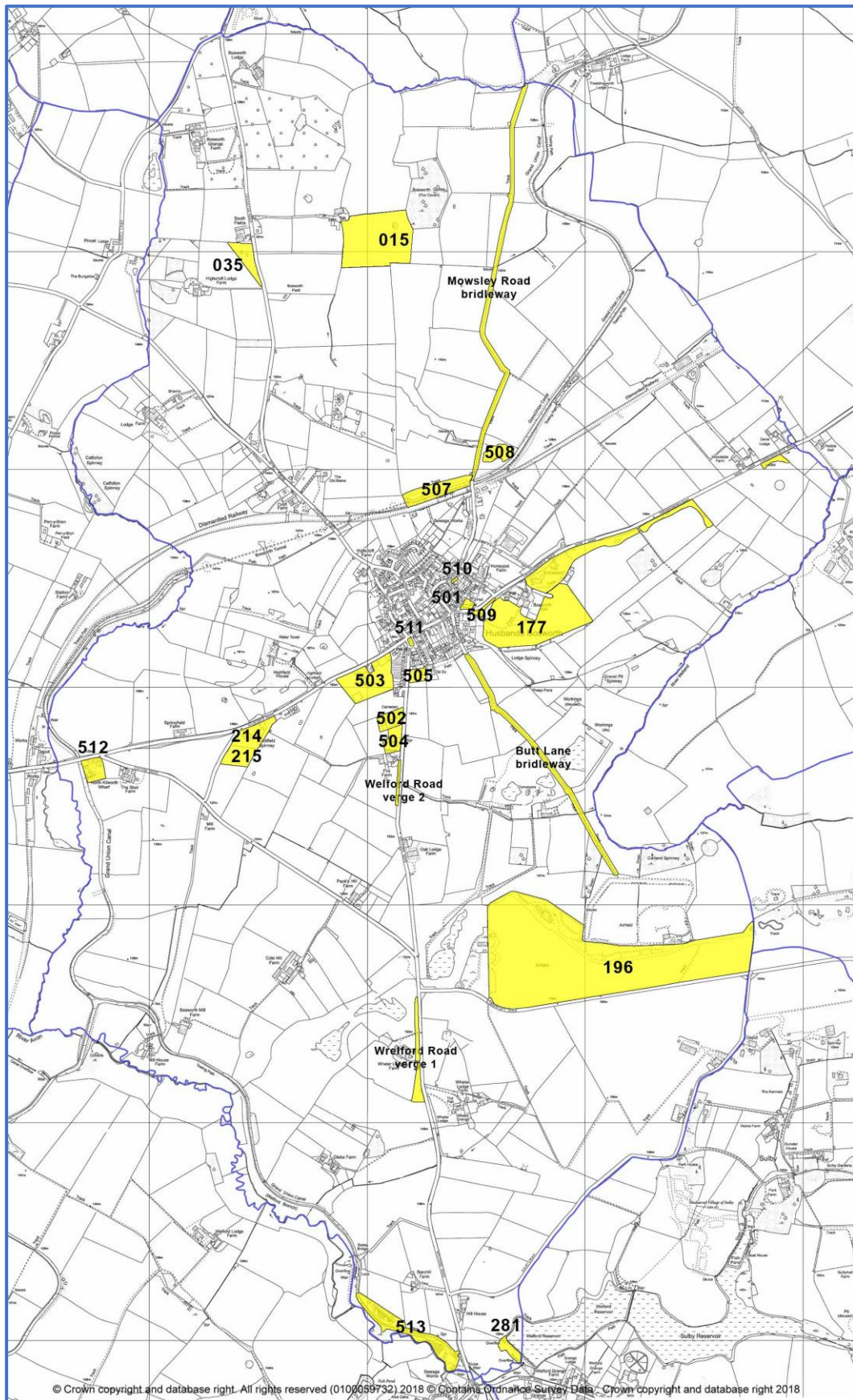


Figure 2: Important Open Spaces outside the built-up area. For village detail see figure 1

**COMMUNITY ACTION ENV 1: OTHER IMPORTANT OPEN SPACE** – The Parish Council will consider undertaking to actively work with Harborough District Council, landowners, the community and other partners to secure the protection of the locations and features of the following open spaces, greenways and footpaths (listed below and mapped in Figures 1 and 2 and detailed in Appendix F) through confirmation as existing, or designation as new, Open Space, Sport and Recreation (OSSR) sites in appropriate typologies, as follows:

## COMMUNITY ACTION ENV 2: BIODIVERSITY

- a) The Parish Council in conjunction with other bodies will consider undertaking to maintain the environmental inventory list of known sites of biodiversity interest prepared for this Plan;
- b) The Parish Council will consider undertaking to work with community groups, landowners, funders and other organisations to enhance the biodiversity of the parish by creating and/or managing habitat sites (e.g. wildflower meadows, woodland, wetland) on suitable parcels of land.

## Facilities and Amenities

COMMUNITY ACTION CA1: FOOTPATHS - The Parish Council will lead in the provision of a new secure footpath/dog walking area and improvements to the canal towpath in conjunction with other bodies.

COMMUNITY ACTION CA2: PLAY EQUIPMENT - The Parish Council will lead in the provision of increased play and exercise equipment to provide a safe and inclusive place for an increasing number of villagers to play and exercise outdoors.

## Transport and Roads

COMMUNITY ACTION T1: TRAFFIC SPEEDING - The Parish Council will consider undertaking to:

- a) Continue to support its own speed signs and monitor patterns.
- b) Ensure that speed control measures are investigated, particularly those suggested via the NP questionnaire feedback.

COMMUNITY ACTION T2: ROAD LAYOUT - The Parish Council will consider undertaking to:

- a) Monitor any increase in accidents within the parish.
- b) Undertake a 'near miss' study at the junctions as per the ROSPA accident investigation process.

COMMUNITY ACTION T3: TRAFFIC VOLUME / TYPE / NOISE - The Parish Council will consider undertaking to:

- a) Source traffic flow records from the County Council and review the necessary figures.
- b) Investigate the options to resolve the issues such as:
  - a. Recommending that large lorries should use other routes where viable.
  - b. That there is a general reduction and restriction of HGV traffic imposed throughout the parish.

COMMUNITY ACTION T4: PARKING - The Parish Council will consider undertaking to:

- a) Carry out a thorough parking survey to assess the issues and provide solutions, this will need to be carried out in conjunction with the County Council.
- b) Carry out an awareness exercise to make explicit the negative impact on residents from parking on pavements.
- c) Following the survey investigate and consult on the following community suggestions to improve the situation.

COMMUNITY ACTION T5: PUBLIC TRANSPORT - The Parish Council will consider undertaking to:

- a) Investigation into what provision the parish could make for a volunteer service, perhaps in cooperation with another parish.
- b) Explore existing systems such as Faxe within the parish and neighbouring areas.

COMMUNITY ACTION T6: TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT - The Parish Council will consider undertaking to:

- a) Improve both vehicular and pedestrian access throughout the village as we encourage higher numbers of people into the community via these new developments including proper village entry treatments;
- b) Review how to encourage residents to move their cars to off-road parking locations by supporting dropping of kerbs and having frontage parking

COMMUNITY ACTION T7: ROAD AND FOOTWAY CONDITION - The Parish Council will consider undertaking to open discussions with relevant authorities to explore the improvement and maintenance of roads and pavements in the village and wider parish. Improvements to be in keeping with the character of the village.
